Call for Submissions!**

The 10th annual Silver Wave Film Festival (SWFF) is now accepting submissions. This year's festival takes place from November 4th to November 7th, 2010.

SWFF is the annual film and video festival presented by the New Brunswick Filmmakers' Co-operative. It has both curated and competitive streams, as well as a solid line-up of social activities and workshops that get the town buzzing.

We will be celebrating our 10th anniversary this year. Save the dates and plan to attend!

Film and video projects that are accepted for screening into the SWFF and created by New Brunswick Filmmakers residing in the province and those filmmakers from away will be considered for the Silver Wave Awards if they follow the criteria of submitting 3 DVDs for the jury.

Most of the major awards are given to New Brunswick residents and proof of residency will be asked for if clarity is needed.

The deadline for submissions is August 3rd, 2010, 5pm Atlantic Standard Time.

Incomplete applications and applications received after this deadline will not be accepted under any circumstances.

The following items must accompany the application:

- Completed Application form, on **CD in an MS Word or .rtf type document;**
- **\$10 Submission Fee (please make cheque payable to NB Film Co-op)**
- List of credits;
- 3 DVD pre-screening copies of the finished project for programming and jury consideration for awards;
- Productions stills, in jpeg format at 300dpi resolution, on CD to be used in festival promotional materials;
- Press Kit (if available of past festival/special screenings of film/video);
- Director's Bio and headshot;
- Poster representing the film or documentary (if available);

NOTE: Submission materials will not be returned to you by the SWFF. After you learn that you are accepted in order for your material to be sent back to you, please enclose a pre-paid envelope with your screening copy of your film. Please email: if you have any questions.
